FUEL PRICE ADJUSTMENT: Wednesday, 1 July 2026

The Department of Mineral and Petroleum Resources (DMPR) has released the new fuel prices for 1 July 2026, reflecting the fuel adjustment effective **00H01 on Wednesday, 1 July 2026 (midnight Tuesday 30 June 2026)**

Petrol

93 ULP & LRP 201.00 cents per litre decrease in retail price.
95 ULP & LRP 196.00 cents per litre decrease in retail price.

Diesel

0,05% Sulphur Content 313.800 cents per litre decrease in wholesale price.
0,005% Sulphur Content 358.800 cents per litre decrease in wholesale price.

Illuminating paraffin

Illuminating paraffin 523.00 cents per litre decrease in wholesale price.
Illuminating paraffin 697.00 cents per litre decrease in Single Maximum National Retail Price (SMNRP)

LPG

16.00 cents per kilogram increase in maximum Retail Price

Note:

In line with the announcement by the Minister of Finance, the short-term fuel levy relief measures have been fully phased out. Consequently, the full fuel levy rates of 429.00 cents per litre on petrol and 416.00 cents per litre on diesel have been reinstated.
